### **MAJOR EVENTS**

- 1. **Seven days Special Camp** The Annual Camp of our NSS unit will be conducted from 07 to 13 September 2019. 100 volunteers will be participating in the camp. The activities such as House Construction, Cleaning programmes, Awareness Campaigns and Surveys will be conducted during the camp. Along with this, different sessions by the resource persons and cultural programmes also will be conducted during the special camp.





### SHUDHIGRAM 2019

### **Proposal Document**

### **Name**

Purpuzha is currently implementing the Haritha Kerala Project under the umbrella of Haritha Gramam which is a project aimed at promoting eco friendliness. However there is a gap in people being able to manage their waste, both bio-degradable and non-biodegradable, at source.

At this juncture our honourable MLA Shri. PJ Joseph has envisioned uplifting Purapuzha Grama panchayath to pioneer an at source waste management programme and thereby bringing in a sustainable model of a waste management programme for Kerala and India as a whole.

It is decided by Shri. PJ Joseph and Purapuzha Grama Panchayath Governance Team that a model of the proposed plan will be implemented initially in Ward 3, consisting of 250 households, of the Purapuzha Panchayath immediately within the next one month and it is envisioned to be then rolled out to the rest of the Panchayath over the next year. It is proposed that Purapuzha Grama Panchayat will be providing bio waste management equipment to all the households in Purapuzha Panchayat commencing with Ward 3 to start off Shudhigram 2019-20.

Under this premise, Santhigiri College is privileged to partner with Mr. P.J Joseph, honourable MLA and Purapuzha Gramapanchayath Governing body to support this cause and hereby propose the following action plan.

### 1. Clustering of 3rd Ward Households with immediate effect

It is proposed that the Ward 3 of Purapuzha Panchayat is clustered into 10 clusters of 25 houses each and a representative of each cluster to attend the training programme on 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2019. This activity is to be coordinated by the Panchayat Governance Team with **immediate effect**.

NOTE: Panchayath members to identify and ensure the participation of the cluster representatives.

### 2. Training Programme

On the 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2019 a training programme is being imparted to the Panchayath members, 85 students of Santhigiri College (57 MSW students and 50 first year NSS volunteers) and 10 selected residents from each cluster. The training is conducted by Mr. Saajeev Vijayan, Founder and Chairman of Green Living School. This will involve both practical and theoretical aspects of environment friendly bio Waste management and non-bio degradable waste (Plastic, glass, leather, electronic etc) segregation at source. The training programme is aimed to equip the attendees to impart practical training programme on Waste Management at source for the residents of Purapuzha Panchayath.

NOTE: Santhigiri College will provide the venue for the training programme.

### 3. Training at Cluster Level in Ward 3

Once the Cluster is identified by the panchayat and a household selected from each cluster to lead the model. The Student trainers will impart the training to ward 3 **within the next two weeks** on a cluster wise basis with the lead household.

<u>The Panchayath has to ensure</u> that Haritha Karma Sena will accompany the trainer Students to each cluster and thereby to each household and students will ensure the training of the houses in the 10 clusters of the 3<sup>rd</sup> ward in Purapuzha Panchayath.

The representatives of the clusters to initiate working models of the waste management units and to pioneer the rolling out of the waste management at source programme.

Note: Students of Santhigiri will further support the 10 representatives from each cluster by training them at the implementation of the waste management units, post its installation by the household / Panchayath.

### 3. Monitoring of the Clusters

Students of Santhigiri will further support the initiative by monitoring the implemented units on a cluster wise basis amounting to two visits in a month until end of February 2020.

# 4. The roll out of the model to the rest of the Panchayat within the next one year Requirements

- 1. Purapuzha Grama Panchayat Governance Team has to provide clarity on frequency, method and provisions for non-biodegradable waste collection.
- 2. The time line proposed has to be strictly followed as students have time constraints detailed by the university due to examinations and academic requirements.

### Suggestions:

- 1. Developing a computer application for monitoring the success of the programme in the implemented houses which will provide the stakeholders an understanding of effectiveness of the programme
- **2.** Provide sustainable segregated bins for the collection in each household for non degradable waste (plastic, electronic, glass). As it is felt that people will be deterred to store non-biodegradable waste in sacks especially during raining season.

A coordinator to be employed by the Purapuzha GramaPanchayat Governance Team to oversee the implementation of the project over the next year.
